NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING


Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the captioned District will hold a public meeting at the office of the **Greater Fort Bend EDC, One Fluor Daniel Drive, Sugar Land, Fort Bend County, Texas.**

The meeting will be held at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9, 2018.** The subject of the meeting is to consider and act on the following:

1. Approve Minutes of September 11 and September 20, 2018 Board of Directors Meetings
2. Report from Pecan Grove Volunteer Fire Department
3. Public Comment (*for matters not on the agenda*). This provides an opportunity for citizens to comment on non-agenda items in advance of regular business of the Board. All members of the public wishing to address the Board must register on a sign-in sheet prior to the posted starting time of the meeting. Comments shall be limited to **two (2) minutes** per person. By state law, comments by the Board members on any item not on the *agenda* shall be limited to: a) Statements of specific factual information given in response to any inquiry; b) A recitation of existing policy in response to any inquiry; or c) A proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a future meeting.

5. Operator's Report; authorize maintenance and repairs, as necessary
6. Bookkeeper's Report; payment of bills
7. Report from Champions Hydro-Lawn; proposals for maintenance of District drainage facilities; take action, as necessary
8. Consider Contract from Mike Stone Associates, Inc. for District Park facilities; authorize additional maintenance, as necessary; District Park facilities; Compensation Matters
